

## **DRESS CODE**

All Pre-Primary to Year Six students are expected to comply with the Narrogin Primary School Dress Code unless an exemption has been granted.

# 1. Requirements

### **Uniforms**

- School monogrammed polo shirt.
- School monogrammed windcheater.
- School monogrammed sport jacket.
- School dress (available from school uniform shop only).
- · Navy track pants, navy shorts or navy skirt.
- Wide-brimmed school hat is to be worn outside at all times.
- Students are encouraged to wear their faction T-shirts (red, green, gold) each Friday and for sports carnivals.
- Annual school 'Leaver's Shirts' for Year 6 students only.

Please note – slogans and images are not permitted on any clothing item.

#### Footwear

- Sandals
- Closed shoes
- Sneakers or joggers

Please note - thongs, masseurs, heeled shoes, wheeled shoes, scuffs and uggs are not permitted.

### Jewellery & Accessories

- Ear studs, sleepers and watches accepted.
- All other jewellery to be kept to a minimum.
- Make up should not be worn.
- Nail polish is only acceptable in clear or skin tones.
- Hair longer than shoulder length is to be tied back.

# 2. Exemptions

Exemptions may be provided by the Principal on the following grounds:

- The unavailability of an item.
- A matter relating to the student's health.
- A matter relating to the religious or cultural beliefs of the student or the student's family.
- Any other matter which in the Principal's opinion is sufficient to exempt the student from complying with the requirement.

### 3. Non Compliance with Dress Code

The following sanctions may be endorsed for a student not complying with the dress code:

- Prevention from attending any activity in which the student would have been representing the school.
- Prevention from attending or participating in any school activity which, in the opinion of the Principal, is not part of the Educational program.
