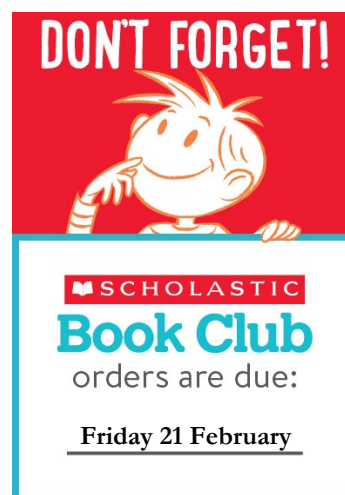
## Library News

So please say hello when you see me around. "Be Kind to yourself"

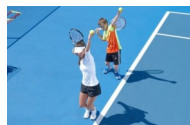
