JULY 1 LIGHTWEIGHT PLASTIC BAG BAN

On Monday 19 February a Narrogin Shire Council community meeting was held in the Town Hall. Mr Harrison, Mrs Filipa Shepherd and 3 student councillors; Maddie Andrews, Lilli Beresford and Natalie Bradford represented Narrogin Primary School at this meeting.

This public meeting was held in response to the announcement made by Premier Mark McGowan in September 2017, promising Western Australia a lightweight plastic bag ban. Already SA, NT, TAS and ACT have banned the bags and most other states are considering it.

From July 1 2018 all retailers can no longer supply lightweight plastic bags to their customers.
