ATTENDANCE REMINDER

The *School Education Act 1999* requires a student of compulsory school age to be enrolled in and attend a school or approved educational programme. The parents/ caregiver must:

- Ensure that a child in their care who is of compulsory school age attends a school or approved educational programme or complies with an alternative attendance arrangement
- Notify the Principal as to the cause of the absence as soon as is practicable and within three school days from which the non-attendance commenced
- On request from the Principal, provide a medical certificate in the case of student illness.

Statistics show that attendance below 90% places a child AT RISK of not achieving their educational potential. It has been pleasing to see that average student attendance for Term 1 at Narrogin Primary School has stayed above 90%. We are looking forward to continued improvement in attendance during Term 2.
