National Assessment Program Literacy & Numeracy - NAPLAN

Term 2 is NAPLAN term and the testing will take place in Week 4, Tuesday 12 May – Friday 15 May for all Year 3 and 5 students.

A pamphlet for parents was sent home late last term with additional information.

Teachers are working hard to prepare students for the tests, especially to help them understand how the tests will be conducted.

This time should not be stressful for students or parents, as it is simply testing knowledge students have gained through previous years of schooling.
