Term 2 has been very busy and productive, and we would like to thank staff and students for their fantastic efforts throughout. Please enjoy a happy and safe holiday.

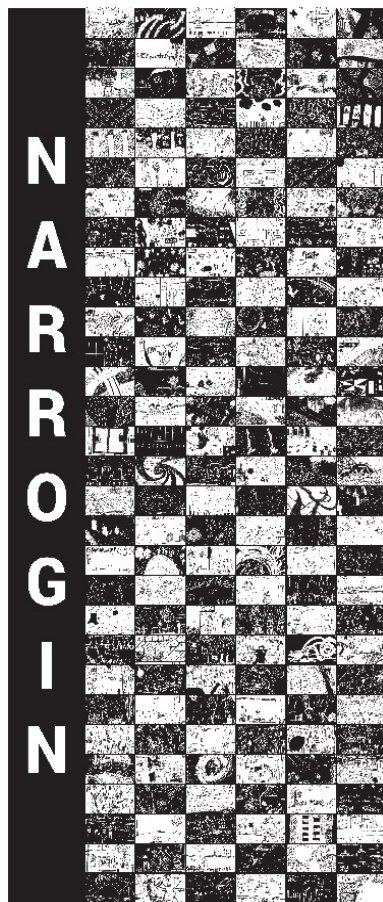
A reminder to Parents that school commences for students on Tuesday 17 July.
