This award also reflects some of the values we share as Australians: a sense of fair play; generosity of spirit; commitment to community participation; a real concern for the environment. We look forward to recognising our 'Aussie of the Month' tomorrow with a certificate and special badge.

TUESDAY AFTER SCHOOL ACTIVITIES

At present we have a number of children participating in our after school activities on Tuesdays during Early Close. A big thank you to our enthusiastic group of education assistants who have been organising an interesting array of activities for the students. There are a lot of students participating which is great – it does mean we are at capacity as far as numbers go. During these sessions, we follow a five similar behaviour management plan as per the school:

Step 1: Verbal Warning

Step 2: Verbal Warning

Step 3: A period of time out from activities

Step 4: Student withdrawn for the remainder of the session. Admin will contact the parent/carer.

Severe Clause (verbal or physical abuse of staff or student, damage to property, intimidating behaviour) – immediate withdrawal of student and admin to contact parent/carer to collect their child.

Please Note: Two withdrawals in a term is automatic exclusion for the remainder of the term – parents will be asked to take responsibility for their child during these sessions.
