Additional information

Faction Polo's

Will I be able to buy a shirt later in the year?

No, School Faction Polo's are an **order only** item and at this stage will only be ordered during 2nd term in preparation for third term.

When is my child allowed to wear their faction shirt?

Children will be able to wear their shirts every Friday for "Faction Friday", during preparation for faction carnivals, during faction carnivals and novelty days.

Is it compulsory to wear faction polo's?

They are not compulsory; however, they are endorsed by the school as part of our sun smart policy because they are rated at UPF 40+.

Are the faction shirts going to have the new logo on them?

Yes, the new logo will be printed on the shirts. The logo will be navy blue, on the left breast and approximately 7cm in size.

My child is in blue faction, can they wear their school polo instead of the blue faction polo?

Yes.

What size should I order?

The shirts are exactly the same in sizing as our current navy polo, so order the size you would normally get for your child.

When do I need to pay for the shirt?

Payment will be taken on arrival of the shirts at the school.

What will the colours look like?

The shirts will be on display in the glass cabinet outside of the front office.

Why does the dress cost so much?

The girls dress is made specifically for our school and sets us apart from other schools. It is made in Australia using quality fabrics and finishing's. It has a princess cut so it's flattering and comfortable for the girls.

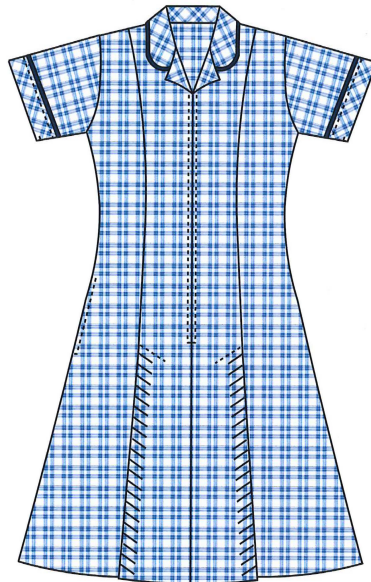
16 weeks from date of order. Hopefully we will receive the dresses in time for the warmer months.
