#### SCHOOL BUS SERVICES

As you may be aware, orange School Bus Services is accepting transport assistance applications for 2019. A transport assistance application needs to be approved by School Bus Services prior to students using a bus if they are starting school for the first time, changing schools or moving address. Students who are already approved to use an orange school bus and are not changing their arrangements do not need to re-register. Students also do not need to re-register if they are transitioning from kindergarten hours to standard pre-primary hours.

Parents can fill out applications either online at [www.schoolbuses.wa.gov.au](http://www.schoolbuses.wa.gov.au), or can contact School Bus Services on 9326 2625 for an application form. Please be aware that due to the need to provide time to plan bus routes and process applications, if applications aren't received before **November 9**, students might not be able to access a service until later in the term, after the routes and timetables have been amended for the start of the year.
