From the Principal

I trust that everyone had a relaxing break and is ready for a very exciting 2017 school year.

During their holidays, teachers worked hard to prepare stimulating lessons for their classes and students have made an enthusiastic start to the year.

I would like to welcome all new students and their families to Narrogin Primary School and also extend a warm welcome to our new staff members, Mrs Georgi (Deputy Principal) and Miss De Aguiar (Year 3 Teacher). Mrs Carter (Deputy Principal) has returned to our school after several years of secondment in other administrative positions in the Narrogin Schools Network.

Renovations to the administration took many weeks and we are still awaiting some works to be completed. I trust that all school community members are accepting of any inconveniences caused by these unfinished works. We hope to be fully operational again within the next two weeks.

During our School Development Planning days, it was necessary to restructure our internal timetable to accommodate our specialist teaching time.
