- You can stop to drop off or pick up children for a maximum of 2 minutes.
- Drivers must remain in or within 3 metres of their vehicles.
- Kiss and Drop zones apply only during hours of school operation.
- 'No Parking On Verge' signs are now erected on the opposite side of the Kiss and Drop zone.

Shire of Narrogin will enforce on-the-spot penalties of \$50 - \$70 for breaches of these conditions.
