- **In-term Swimming Lessons**
In term swimming is held at the Narrogin Leisure Centre pool. Students who do not have a pool pass are required to pay for entry.
- **Talented Young Writer Program**
The Talented Young Writer Program is an opportunity for year 6 students to attend the Fremantle Literacy Centre and participate in a workshop with some talented authors (4 sessions).
Parents will need to organise their own transport.
- **Special Sporting Event Entry Fee**
The special sporting event entry fee is payable if a student is selected to participate in the State Cross Country or similar sporting events.
- **BYOD**
Narrogin Primary School will continue an optional ‘Bring Your Own Device’ (BYOD) laptop computer program for Year 4 - 6. Parents may purchase one of the computer models the school has chosen through

our BYOD Portal or purchase the same machine at a retailer of their choosing. It will be the Parents' responsibility to make sure the device is insured under their Home and Contents or other insurance program.

- **Incursions**

The School Board recognises the value of incursions for students and seeks to support teachers who coordinate them as part of their teaching programs. Other incursions may occur throughout the year.

- **Excursions**

The School Board recognises the value of excursions for students and seeks to support teachers who coordinate them as part of their teaching programs. Excursions for the purposes of this document are defined as outings that do not include an overnight stay.

- **Camp – Year 6**

From time to time, teachers offer to coordinate camps. The School Board has agreed that the maximum charge to parents for any official school camp should not exceed the figure shown.

- **Graduation**

The Year 6 Parent Committee may request some money for providing a meal/disco after the Year 6 formal Graduation Ceremony.

- **Instrumental Music/Band & Music camp (Narrogin Senior High School)**

Students sit a music test in Year 4 for the opportunity to attend music lessons at Narrogin Senior High School in Year 5 & 6. Parents will need to organise their own transport to NSHS for lessons. Students participating in Instrumental music lessons at NSHS may be required to purchase a music book, black display folder and 2B lead pencil. Students can also attend music/band camp.

- **Mastery folder**

A Mastery learning folder is a tool that makes individualised and systematic practise manageable by students of all ages. Narrogin PS will supply the first folder for students, if this is lost or damaged then parents will be asked to pay for the replacement.

- **Leadership Day**

Year 6 Students may be given the opportunity to participate in a Leadership Day in Perth.

- **Leavers Shirt**

Students are given the opportunity to purchase a 'leaver's shirt' to wear in their last year at primary school. The Year 6 teacher will consult with students on design and order in term 1. These shirts are usually worn for Graduation.

- **Choir**

Our school choir generally meets two lunch times a week. Typically, the choir participates in the One Big Voice event that is held at the RAC Arena.

- **PEAC Excursions**

Selected students may have the opportunity to participate in excursions organised by the PEAC teacher.

The school and P&C will supply generic sunscreen which is available for use in each class and sport lesson. However, if your child is sensitive to generic brands you may wish to supply your own.
