
KINDERGARTEN 2021 – INFORMATION SHEET

Thank you for choosing Narrogin Primary School (Kindergarten) as your preferred school in 2021. Please read the following information that will assist you to complete the application for enrolment process:

Do I need to provide any identification records?

You will need to provide evidence of your child's date of birth, immunisation records, and any family court orders at the time of application. You may also be requested to provide proof of your usual place of residence.

Does this application guarantee my child a place in Narrogin Primary School's Kindergarten program?

This is an Application for Enrolment only. Submitting this form to the school does not mean that the enrolment has been accepted by the school. All applications will be assessed during Term 3. The Principal will determine a child's eligibility for enrolment based on classroom accommodation, an appropriate educational program being available for your child at the school, and his or her specialised health care needs. When the number of applications from eligible children exceeds the number of places available at the school, the Principal will determine enrolments based on Department of Education Local Intake Area Schools criteria as follows:

1. 1st priority - A child living in the school intake area and with siblings enrolled at Narrogin Primary School in 2021.
2. 2nd priority – A child living in the school intake area and with no siblings enrolled at Narrogin Primary School in 2021.
3. 3rd priority – A child not living in the school intake area but with siblings enrolled at Narrogin Primary school in 2021.
4. 4th priority – A child not living in the school intake area and with no siblings enrolled at Narrogin Primary School in 2021.

All successful and unsuccessful applicants will be notified by mail when the application process is finished. If your application is accepted, you will be required to complete further enrolment information.

The school will make every effort to organise classes, days and times in consultation with parents and carers. School staff reserve the right to make final decisions involving class groupings and/or the allocation of days and times in order to meet Narrogin Primary School requirements.

When can my child start Kindergarten?

Children who turn four between 1 July 2020 and 30 June 2021 will be eligible to enter a Kindergarten program at the beginning of the 2021 school year. These children were born between 1 July 2016 and 30 June 2017.

How often can my child attend Kindergarten?

In 2021, the Kindergarten program will offer fifteen hours of weekly instruction. The Kindergarten program offered at Narrogin Primary School will be determined in Term 4 and will be dependent upon student numbers.

If I apply at more than one school would this affect the enrolment process?

Applying at more than one school prevents a school from knowing which school is preferred, and it can also jeopardise the placement of your child and other children. All eligible children are guaranteed a Kindergarten placement although not necessarily at the school of their choice – see above priority list.

Does my child being accepted for enrolment for Kindergarten mean they will automatically continue on to Pre-Primary at this school?

If you wish your child to remain at this school, you will be required to sign this Application for Enrolment Form in July 2021 to apply for Pre-Primary. The same criteria for enrolment apply as for Kindergarten.
