STUDENTS ARRIVING EARLY TO SCHOOL

The school does not provide supervision prior to 8.30am in the morning. We ask that students are not on school premises before this time. Students are required to go directly to their classrooms after an 8.30am arrival to prepare for the day. If students do arrive early, they are required to sit on the seats outside the junior cluster. Exception to this rule is if they are attending breakfast club. Breakfast is served at 8.15am (see Chaplain's Chat).

These will be entered on the system on Wednesday mornings. If you could please ensure that you drop your passport and earning slip (these can be found on the counter in the front office) or list, to the front office and place them in the Passport box on the counter before Wednesday. These will then be updated and returned home with your child.
